



Summer School 2010 Terms and Conditions

This document serves to notify students about important information concerning Financial Aid for summer. Summer school is a part of the preceding award year, thus this document supplements the [2009-2010 Award Terms & Conditions](#).

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Summer School is a part of the 2009-2010 award year for financial aid purposes. This means that the student is eligible for summer school aid when (s)he has remaining unused funds from the 2009-2010 academic year. **The student must be admitted to a degree-seeking program of study at Atlanta's John Marshall Law School (JMLS). Transient students are eligible for Federal financial assistance. JMLS students who will be transient students elsewhere are required to enter into consortium agreement with the "host" institution for the purpose of providing Title IV aid to the JMLS student. JMLS does not admit students to degree-seeking programs during summer school.**
2. **To qualify for a Federal Stafford Loan in the summer, the student must have qualified during the 2009-2010 academic year and have not utilized the maximum annual amount.** For example: A student has access to a maximum of \$20,500 annually. If the student used \$13,000 during the 2009-2010 academic year, (s)he would have remaining loan amount of \$7,500 for summer, dependent upon the number of enrolled hours in summer. *Graduate PLUS and Alternative loans do not have an annual loan maximum (unless set by the lender) and are available to students who meet credit standards.*
3. The student must enroll in three or more credit hours during the summer term to be considered at least at half-time status.
4. The student must meet all eligibility criteria of the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy for federal financial aid recipients as of the end of Spring 2010. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the cancellation of aid. This policy can be found in the Terms & Conditions document available on the Office of Financial Aid [website](#).

Application Procedure for Summer Federal Assistance:

1. The 2009-2010 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must have been received by April 5, 2010. (For students who received student aid at JMLS in 2009-2010, the FAFSA may already be on file.)
2. Register for classes for the Summer Semester.
3. **Submit the "Summer 2010 Financial Aid Application" after you have registered for your classes, but no later than April 5, 2010.** Summer awards are based on the actual number of hours for which you have been officially registered. Inform our office if your enrollment changes for your aid to be adjusted.

Summer Disbursement:

In the summer, excess financial aid funds will not be released until the day following the last day of the drop/add period.

Notify the Office of Student Financial Aid of Changes When:

1. Your course schedule has changed resulting in fewer hours or more hours. Such changes will impact the amount of aid you are eligible to receive. Your enrollment will be audited at the end of summer to verify your **actual** enrollment in all terms. Failure to maintain enrollment in the proper number of hours noted on your Summer School 2010 Financial Aid Application will result in your having to immediately *repay* any over awarded funds.
2. You wish to decline or reduce any financial aid award.
