

Summer School 2009 Terms and Conditions

This document serves to notify students about important information concerning Financial Aid for summer. Summer school is a part of the preceding award year, thus this document supplements the [2008-2009 Award Terms & Conditions](#).

Eligibility Criteria:

1. Summer School is a part of the 2008-2009 award year for financial aid purposes. This means that the student is eligible for summer school aid when (s)he has remaining unused funds from the 2008-2009 academic year. **The student must be admitted to a degree-seeking program of study at John Marshall Law School – Atlanta (JMLS). Transient students are not eligible for Federal financial assistance. JMLS students who will be transient students elsewhere are not eligible for financial aid through JMLS. JMLS does not admit students to degree-seeking programs during summer school.**
2. **To qualify for a Federal Stafford Loan in the Summer, the student must have qualified during the 2008-2009 academic year and have not utilized the maximum annual amount.** For example: A student has access to a maximum of \$18,500 annually. If the student used \$13,000 during the 2008-2009 academic year, (s)he would have remaining loan amount of \$5,500 for summer, dependent upon the number of enrolled hours in summer. Graduate PLUS and Alternative loans do not have an annual loan maximum (unless set by the lender) and are available to students who meet credit standards.
3. The student must enroll in three or more hours over the Summer term.
4. The student must meet all eligibility criteria of the Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) Policy for federal financial aid recipients as of the end of Spring 2009. Failure to comply with this policy will result in the cancellation of aid. This policy can be found in the Terms & Conditions document available on the Office of Financial Aid [website](#).

Application Procedure for Summer Federal Assistance:

1. The 2008-2009 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must have been received by April 1, 2009. (For students who received student aid at JMLS in 2008-2009, the FAFSA may already be on file.)
2. Register for classes for the Summer School term.
3. **Submit the "Summer 2009 Financial Aid Application" after you have registered for your classes, but no later than April 1, 2009.** Summer awards are based on the actual number of hours for which you have been officially registered. Inform our office if your enrollment changes for your aid to be adjusted.

Summer Disbursement:

In the summer, excess financial aid funds will not be released until the tuition and fees for all classes of summer school have been deducted.

Notify the Office of Financial Assistance of Changes When:

1. Your course schedule has changed resulting in fewer hours or more hours. Such changes will impact the amount of aid you are eligible to receive. Your enrollment will be audited at the end of summer to verify your **actual** enrollment in all terms. Failure to maintain enrollment in the proper number of hours noted on your Summer School 2009 Financial Aid Application will result in your having to immediately *repay* the over-paid funds.
2. You wish to decline or reduce any financial aid award.
3. You wish to borrow less than the amount awarded under the Federal Loan programs.

To notify the Office of Financial Aid about any circumstance above, e-mail your request to jsmith@johnmarshall.edu so the aid may be adjusted. Be specific about the type of aid involved in the change and the amount you wish to receive.
