- 1. As part of their scheduled academic progress, first-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Criminal Law. Criminal Law is also open to students in the full-time division.
- 2. As part of their scheduled academic progress, third-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Professional Responsibility. Professional Responsibility is also open to students in the full-time division who have completed their second year. Priority will be given to third-year part-time students.
- 3. Pass/Fail.
- 4. Externships are open to students who have satisfactorily completed all first year courses, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least a 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in two to six (2-6) credits in the Fall and Spring Semesters. Maximum of 12 externship credits may be earned in externship placements.
- 5. Enrollment limited to twenty (20) students.
- 6. Recommended Prerequisite: Sales & Secured Transactions.
- 7. Advanced standing required. Advanced standing requires completion of the first year of the full-time division and the second year of the part-time division.
- 8. This is an online course to be held on TWEN.
- 9. Prerequisite: Wills, Trusts & Estates and/or Federal Income Taxation.
- 10. Enrollment limited to sixteen (12) students.
