2. Externships are open to students who have satisfactorily completed all first year courses, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in 2 to 6 (2-6) credits in the Fall and Spring Semesters. Maximum of 12 credits may be earned in externship placements.
3. Enrollment is limited to twenty (20) students.
4. Advanced standing required. Advanced standing requires completion of the first year of the full-time division and the second year of the part-time division.
