- 2. Externships are open to students who have satisfactorily completed all first year courses, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in 2 to 6 (2-6) credits in the Fall and Spring Semesters. Maximum of 12 credits may be earned in externship placements.
- 3. Enrollment is limited to twenty (20) students.
- 4. Advanced standing required. Advanced standing requires completion of the first year of the full-time division and the second year of the part-time division.
