## **FOOTNOTES:**

- <sup>1</sup> As part of their scheduled academic progress, first-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Criminal Law. Criminal Law is also open to students in the full-time division. Priority goes to the part-time students.
- <sup>2</sup> As part of their scheduled academic progress, third-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Professional Responsibility. Professional Responsibility is also open to students in the full-time division who have completed their second year. Priority will be given to third-year part-time students.
- <sup>3</sup> Externships are open to students who have satisfactorily completed all first year courses, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least a 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in two to six (2-6) credits in the Summer Semester. Maximum of 12 externship credits may be earned in externship placements.
- <sup>4</sup> Enrollment limited to twenty (20) students.
- <sup>5</sup> Advanced standing required. Advanced standing requires completion of the first year of the full-time division and the second year of the part-time division.
- <sup>6</sup> This is an online course to be held on TWEN.
- <sup>7</sup> Enrollment limited to sixteen (16) students.
- <sup>8</sup> Students cannot enroll in both Jurisprudence & Writing and Int'l Business Transactions & Writing, Students may take only one of these courses during this session.
- <sup>9</sup> Enrollment limited to twenty (22) students.
- <sup>10</sup> 2L Part-time students in the bottom half of the class (at the end of Fall Semester) will be pre-registered and must take and pass Advanced Analytical Methods.
- <sup>11</sup> Satisfies upper level writing requirement.
