FOOTNOTES:

¹ As part of their scheduled academic progress, first-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Criminal Law. Criminal Law is also open to students in the full-time division. Priority goes to the part-time and January Start students.

² As part of their scheduled academic progress, third-year students in the part-time program are required to complete Professional Responsibility. Professional Responsibility is also open to students in the full-time division who have completed their second year. Priority will be given to third-year part-time students.

³ Externships are open to students who have satisfactorily completed all first year courses, are in good academic standing, and have a grade point average of at least a 2.00. Subject to securing a placement, eligible students may enroll in two to six (2-6) credits in the Summer Semester. Maximum of 12 externship credits may be earned in externship placements.

⁴ 2L Part-time students in the bottom half of the class (at the end of Fall Semester) will be pre-registered and must take and pass Advanced Analytical Methods.

⁵ Enrollment limited to twelve (12) students.

⁶ This class meets for seven (7) weeks commencing on Tuesday, May 27, 2014 and concludes on Thursday, July 10, 2014.

⁷ Prerequisite: Evidence.
