

### JD Tuition Installment Payment Program Fall Semester 2025

Students who are current in their financial obligations to the Law School may elect to participate in the Tuition Installment Payment Program. Students who are interested in participating in the Program must contact the Bursar's Office before registration. To participate, students must execute a Promissory Note, pay a \$75 participation fee and make a minimum tuition payment of \$500. The remaining balance of tuition are paid in four (4) monthly installments due on the 15<sup>th</sup> of the following months: August, September, October, and November 2025.

To take advantage of the full 4 months, enrollment in the program should occur before the first installment due date of August 15, 2025.

If you enroll later, your first payment is due at the time of enrollment.

A \$75 non-refundable late penalty shall be assessed for each installment not received by the 20<sup>th</sup> of the month in which the payment is due. If payment is not received by Atlanta's John Marshall Law School by the 30<sup>th</sup> of the month in which the payment is due, the student shall be deemed in default and shall be academically withdrawn from the Law School with no automatic right to readmission. A student in default shall not be allowed to sit for examinations.

Atlanta's John Marshall Law School reserves the right to terminate the student's participation in the Tuition Installment Payment Program if the student is chronically late in making payment under the terms of their Promissory Note. A student shall be deemed chronically late if the student makes more than two late payments. A student need not be in default to be deemed chronically late.

A student who defaults on the terms of this Promissory Note shall also be liable for the costs incurred by Atlanta's John Marshall Law School in collecting the unpaid principal amount and accrued interest, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, costs, and collection service fees.

A student who defaults on the terms of this Promissory Note shall also be liable for interest on the unpaid principal. Interest shall accrue from the date of default at a rate of seven (7) per cent simple interest per annum. Once a student has been terminated from the Tuition Installment Payment Program, the student is required to pay tuition in full on the first day of class for future semesters.
