- 6. Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a law professor who taught the applicant.
- 7. Submit a letter of good academic standing from the Dean of the law school you are transferring from.
- 8. Per Section 306 (b) (2) of the Dean's Office Regulations in the Student Handbook, upon acceptance, transfer students must apply to the Associate Dean of Academics, in writing, by filing a petition for the requested transfer credits.

In addition to a bar examination, there are character, fitness, and other qualifications for admission to the bar in every U.S. jurisdiction. Applicants are encouraged to determine the requirements for any jurisdiction in which they intend to seek admission by contacting the jurisdiction.
